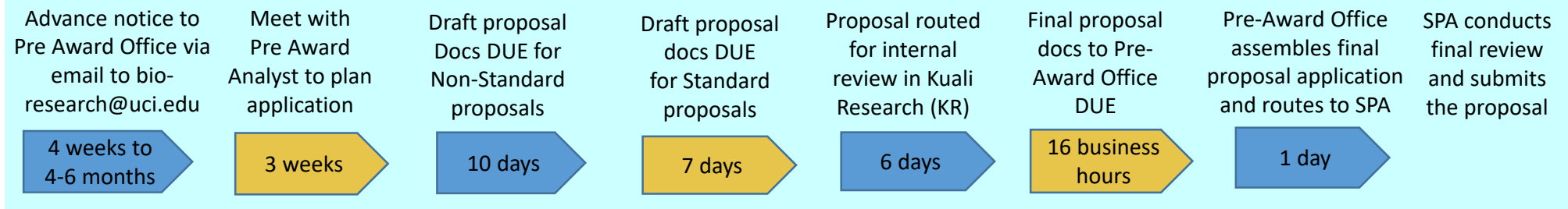


TIMELINE



Advance Notice to Pre-Award Office via email

1. Letter of Intent/Pre-Proposal: 3 weeks advance notice
2. Proposals with only UCI Investigators: 4 weeks advance notice
3. Multi-Investigator (Subcontracts): 6 weeks advance notice
4. Major Projects (Multiple Subcontracts, Center Proposal, Cooperative Agreement, Program Projects): 12 weeks advance notice
5. Training Grants: 4 - 6 Months advance notice

Draft Proposal docs for Internal Review in Kualu Research (Budget Finalized)

Standard Proposal

7 business days before deadline

UCI Investigators, Single Investigator grants, Individual Fellowships,

Non-Standard Proposal

10 business days before deadline

1. By virtue of submitting the proposal to the Extramural sponsor, UCI is accepting award terms and conditions contained in the FOA
2. U.S. federal government contract – not a grant or cooperative agreement
3. Training Grant
4. Foreign Sponsor
5. Requires the submission of a small business subcontracting plan, an intellectual property management plan, a laboratory safety plan, or any other plan(s) that must be developed by one or more UCI central administration office.
6. Proposal requests funding in excess of \$5 million of direct costs per budget year
7. Purpose of the proposal is to establish a new UCI center or institute

Final Submission Deadline

For final submission, both the Sponsored Projects and the Pre-Award office need to receive the final proposal documents 16 business hours prior to submission deadline time. (e.g. If the proposal is due Friday at 5pm, the final proposal docs are due Thursday at 8 am.)

The safe scenario is to provide the Pre-Award office the final proposal documents 16 business hours prior to deadline. This will allow ample time to address any errors, warnings, or the need to replace a document that may arise. We want to see your application successfully submitted. So please, submit early.
